Limited data availability for invited modules

In 2018, the German Center for Gerontology (DZA) invited researchers for the first time to contribute their own survey content to the German Ageing Survey. Researchers whose modules were included in the DEAS 2020/21 were promised exclusive advance access to the data.

Interested researchers will be able to apply for and receive the DEAS on a regular basis starting in June 2022. However, **for the time being, the data will not include the variables on the invited modules**. There is an embargo period of 6 months to give the researchers who submitted the modules a head start on analyzing the modules.

All researchers with a valid data use agreement will be sent a download link with password in January 2023 without having to reapply for it. With this, the complete data including the modules can be downloaded.

Not only for this we need valid (email) addresses - so please keep us informed about address changes! The full SUF DEAS 2021 with the modules is to be released in January and will have a new DOI.

The modules cover the following topics:

- a) Age-related withdrawal and activation norms
- b) Big Five Inventory (BFI-S)
- c) Preferred and subjective life expectancy
