


DEAS-Instrument 2017:
Erhobene Merkmale zu
Enkelkindern



=\$=Nummer des Kindes (1-8)

*=Buchstabe des Enkels (a-j)

Einzelnenkel: einziges Kind eines Kindes.

Basisenkel: mehrere Kinder eines Kindes; zu jedem werden die Fragen des Basisenkelblocks gestellt.


Zufallsenkel: ein Enkelkind, das unter seinen Geschwistern zufällig ausgewählt wird; zu ihm werden zusätzlich zu den Basisfragen vertiefende Fragen gestellt. Sofern bei Panelbefragten bereits in der Vorwelle Fragen zu einem Zufallsenkel dieses Kindes gestellt wurden, betreffen die aktuellen Fragen wieder dieses reidentifizierte Enkelkind.

¹⁾ Wohnentfernung zum Enkel wird nicht erhoben, wenn Enkel im Haushalt des Kindes wohnt; in diesen Fällen wird die Wohnentfernung zum Kind (309, 312) verwendet.

²⁾ Kontakthäufigkeit mit Enkel wird nicht erhoben für Enkel unter 16 Jahren. Sofern Enkel beim Kind wohnt, kann ersatzweise die Kontakthäufigkeit mit dem Kind (311a) verwendet werden.

³⁾ Wohnentfernung des Basisenkels wird ausschließlich erhoben, wenn das Kind der Zielperson bereits verstorben ist, da in diesen Fällen die Frage nach dem Zusammenleben von Enkel und Kind entfällt.
